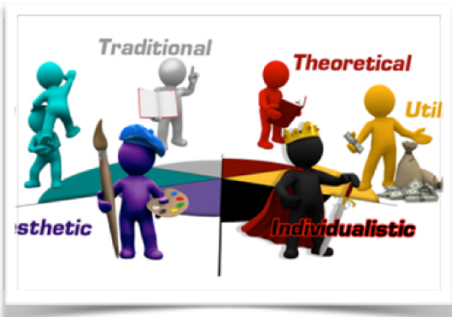

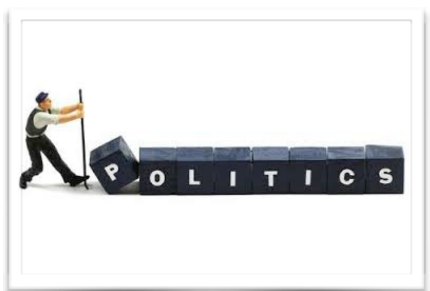
## Highly Effective Teams
