WHAT WE ARE DOING

Throughout Spring and Summer 2022 [The 30x30 Initiative](#) and Mind's Eye Productions, in partnership with [Mark43](#), will host a series of roundtable discussions to explore the experiences of women in policing, identify common challenges and collaboratively generate solutions.

We will host three to four regional listening sessions across the country to bring together sworn women officers from 30x30 participating agencies. We will use the *Women in Blue* documentary, produced by Mind's Eye Productions - which chronicles women officers fighting for reform in the Minneapolis Police Department - as a basis for our discussion. We will use this foundation as the basis of a robust training curriculum designed to advance women in policing and ensure law enforcement agencies are places where diverse officers thrive.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

At least one week in advance, we will distribute a private link to *Women in Blue* so you can view the documentary at your own pace and convenience. At the Listening Session, which will last three hours and include a series of group and breakout discussions, you can expect an open dialogue with other women officers from your agency and other neighboring agencies. These conversations will be private and any notes or themes that arise from our conversation will be anonymous.

Your input, experiences, and knowledge then will help inform and prioritize solutions most likely to improve the representation and experiences of women across all ranks. Ultimately, your contributions are the foundation of an effort to develop and disseminate resources to 30x30 agencies and beyond, addressing common policy and culture issues and advancing promising solutions.
